A unique attraction over the KOTR event is the Bush Festival featuring a host of entertaining traditional activities including bush poetry, famous folklore, fun competitions, bushman's skill displays, billygoat cart races, live music and good old fashioned Upper Hunter hospitality.

King of the Ranges Stockman's Challenge Inc. is a not-for-profit, volunteer organisation of locals who in turn return support to other local groups.

OUR STORY IT ALL BEGAN...

... in 2001 when Upper Hunter stockmen competed in the Man from Snowy River Stockman's Challenge in Corryong Victoria. Enthused by the concept, volunteers formed the King of the Ranges Stockman's Challenge with a mission to preserve and bring to public attention the traditional skills of Australian stockmanship and bushcraft.

The inaugural event was held in 2004 in Murrurundi.

Tales of local stockman, Archie 'Bung' McInnes (b. 1885) inspire the King of the Ranges legend. Archie spent his life working on local cattle stations Tomalla and Glenrock and at the outbreak of World War I he enlisted and saw 3 years of service with the 1st Australian Light Horse Regiment. Archie was seriously wounded at Beersheba, Palestine and later decorated with the Military Medal.

After the war, Archie continued as a stockman and champion buckjumper and was known far and wide as 'King of the Ranges' for his rodeo success and horsemanship in difficult terrain. Archie died in 1940 exactly as he wished 'with my boots on and in the saddle.'

Choosing to sponsor the King of the Ranges Stockmans Challenge keeps the heritage of our Australian stockmen alive whilst connecting with a broad and interested audience.

STOCKMANS CHALLENGE

The King of the Ranges Stockmans competitors must win the highest number of points over 7 challenges to be eligible to compete in the final events on Sunday. During Friday and Saturday competitors in the Open, Restricted Open, Novice and Junior complete 7 events which are based on Stockman's daily work. The challenge events are;

STOCKMAN'S GEAR CHECK

Dress in and use gear for rugged bush riding. Horse and rider gear must comply with the recognised criteria of Australian gear for daily work and be deemed by the Judge to be safe and suitable.

BAREBACK

Catch a horse in the morning and ride bareback to the campsite. Riding bareback and using a choice of headgear competitors must complete a course designed to demonstrate rider skill, control and manoeuvrability of their horse. Then perform a 60 second freestyle routine.

PACKHORSE

Pack a packsaddle and lead a pack horse, through the bush. Within a set time competitors must pack their competition horse ensuring that the bags are balanced. The packhorse is then led through a course of obstacles to reach the campsite where the packsaddle is removed, bags unpacked and the competition horse re-saddled.

STOCKHANDLING

Work groups of cattle free from the mob, using a horse and a dog. Within a set time competitors must cut out one beast in campdraft format and then in a controlled manner using a dog, move three beasts through set obstacles.



WHIPCRACK

Crack a stock whip to control stock when riding at speed. Within a set time competitors must negotiate a course attempting to cleanly cut targets then perform a 30 second freestyle routine with the horse standing still.

HORSE SHOEING

Shoe a horse so that it can be ridden over rugged country. Competitors are allowed tools of their choice at the horse but only a hammer and pritchel at the stalljack. Within a set time and depending on category, competitors prepare and shoe one or two hooves.

CROSS COUNTRY

Gallop over logs, down banks and through streams when mustering. Riding in a stock saddle, competitors must complete a 2km course with 20 jumps, as close as possible to an optimum time which is based on a horse speed of 425m per minute.

The Open Challenge Finalists compete in a wild horse catch, stocksaddle buckjump attempting to ride a bucking horse for 8 seconds whilst cracking a stockwhip.

Talented local Steve Kemp will be helping young aspiring whip crackers perfect their technique during the Saturday Clinic and then he will judge performances in the Junior Whipcrack Competition.

BILLY BOILING COMPETITION

Use as many matches as you like but you cannot burn the box! Open to all, this highly competitive and fun contest is one to make sure you have front row seats at.



WORKING DOG INVITATIONAL

This competitive event brings out the best in owners and their dogs to decide the winner of the King of the Ranges Champion Working Dog.

HAY STACKING AND PUMPKIN SNATCH

Watch the gentle giants of the horse world compete for the ribbon as pumpkins are picked up and placed on the slide as the slide is driven alongside the row of pumpkins.

HEAVY HORSE DISPLAY

Relive history watching the working exhibitions and displays of heavy horses in action. There will be the beautifully decorated harness displays, working team ploughing obstacle courses and of course the pumpkin snatch race.

BLACKSMITH DEMONSTRATION

Watch the sparks fly as the blacksmiths turn up the heat on iron to create useful, important and decorative items.

BUILDING OUR NEXT GEN

KOTR INDIGENOUS STOCKMAN PROGRAM

King of the Ranges members Louise and Shane Easey initiated the King of the Ranges Indigenous Stockman Program in 2015. Supported by Lawn Hill Pastoral Company until 2017 they coordinated a program to assist young Aboriginal stockmen from Northern Australia to develop skills and experiences which may benefit their careers.

Successful recipients travel to the Upper Hunter, are billeted with the Easey Family at their Willow Tree property and spend time under the guidance of experienced King of the Ranges members, improving specific skills required to compete in a Stockman's Challenge.

Always welcomed by the local community, the young stockmen also participate in a range of activities aimed to increase confidence and further their all round development.

From 2018 the program continued successfully with assistance from The Aboriginal Development Benefits Trust.
